AND NOW, this 1 day of December, 2005, it has come to the Court's attention that litigants are being put to unnecessary expense by the requirement to file three (3) copies of pretrial memoranda in equitable distribution cases. The Court needs only the original pretrial statement. Supplemental copies are not necessary. Effective this date, Lycoming County Local Rule 212 is not controlling as to equitable distribution pretrial cases. Only the original pretrial statement shall be filed by each side in any equitable distribution pretrial. Any party filing exceptions to a master's decision in equitable distribution shall indicate on the L206 the name of the Judge who presided at the pretrial.
