- ▶ **Commonwealth vs. Winters** (12/23/2015)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio
Criminal: Habeas corpus petition; failure to comply with registration of sexual offender’s requirements; sufficiency of evidence; fact finder’s evaluation of the weight and credibility of the testimony. (Winters122315L)
- ▶ **Commonwealth vs. Buie** (12/22/2015)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio
Criminal: Post Conviction Relief Act petition; ineffectiveness of counsel, illegal sentence, and judicial misconduct; timeliness; *Alleyne* argument; retroactive application of new constitutional right. (Buie122215m)
- ▶ **Commonwealth vs. Laury** (12/23/2015)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio
Criminal: Appeal; claimed excessive sentence; extensive criminal record; several prior opportunities for rehabilitation; court comments that defendant was in the “business of killing people” by selling drugs; failure to accept responsibility for conduct or expressing remorse; activity that presents a clear and present danger to the community. (Laury122315L)
- ▶ **Commonwealth vs. Williams** (12/23/2015)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio
Criminal: Motion to quash subpoena of medical records; HIPPA compliance; HIPPA definition of covered entity; hospital’s notice requirements; disclosure of medical records for law enforcement purposes; relevance of medical records for injuries sustained during flight from police; consciousness of guilt; suppression as remedy for violation of HIPPA: Uniform Act to Secure Out of State Witnesses as method to secure medical records. (Williams122315L)
- ▶ **Commonwealth vs. Coleman** (12/21/2015)—Judge Marc F. Lovecchio
Criminal: Suppression motion; probable cause for warrant to search smartphone based on the amount of cash and marijuana in defendant’s possession and belief that defendant was selling marijuana; overbroad warrant that allows search of all content on smartphone. (Coleman122115bt)
