The Young Lawyer's Division (YLD), completing its second year of activity, accomplished a number of goals during 2006.

In the spring, the YLD successfully sponsored a canned food drive to benefit St. Anthony's.

The YLD had a noticeable presence this summer at the two planned LLA social events: the LLA Summer Picnic and the Crosscutters Baseball game.

YLD focused on plans for the Lawtoberfest. The Lawtoberfest, which occurred in October, was a social event open to the entire LLA and held at the Jeremiah's above the Bullfrog Brewery. Approximately 40 LLA members and guests joined the YLD for this first event. During the Lawtoberfest, a silent auction was held. All proceeds (over \$1000) from the Lawtoberfest's auction and ticket sales was donated to the Lycoming Law Foundation.

The YLD also held a YLD bowling night at Faxon Lanes in November. This event generated good attendance from the YLD membership (approximately 12 members joined us). During the month of December, the YLD once again sponsored the reception at the Old Corner immediately following the admission ceremony. Our members also once again sponsored the Angel Toy Drive that benefited the Salvation Army.

The YLD successfully completed some excellent projects during 2006. The YLD hopes that in 2007, some of these events, such as the Lawtoberfest, grow and become even more popular with the YLD and the LLA.
