

2006 PRO BONO REPORT

For calendar year 2006, **70** Lycoming Law Association members handled **150** cases, **5** divorce clinics, **2** research projects, supervised **18** custody clinics, and conducted one community education program. The following is a breakdown of the types of cases:

- 129 Protection From Abuse Cases
- 21 Other civil legal issues, including unemployment compensation, criminal expungement, tax issues, estate matters, education, family, guardianship, public housing, landlord and tenant, and law suit defense.
- 100 Individuals helped in the clinics

Two CLE's were held locally and were jointly sponsored by North Penn Legal Services and the Law Association . These programs were offered at no cost to Pro Bono volunteers and to those willing to begin taking referrals. The topics were Education Law and Personal Care Home Regulations. In April of this year, a CLE was offered to Pro Bono attorneys on the newly enacted amendments to the Protection from Abuse Act.
