

BAR HISTORY COMMITTEE OF THE LYCOMING LAW ASSOCIATION, 2011

The LLA and this Committee continue to update biographies, identification, and sketches maintained and coordinated through Gary Weber, Esquire, Web Master. All members of the Association are encouraged to continue to review their own biographies, and provide updates and anecdotal information for our deceased members.

During 2011, two esteemed lawyers of the County and Association passed away, after engaged in illustrious and ongoing careers. Henry Clay McCormick, a founding member of the present McCormick firm, who had retired in 1978, passed away February 10, 2011, while residing in his long-time home in Florida.

Notably, our senior member and mentor of the Association, Judge Malcolm Muir died on Friday, July 22, 2011. On Monday, July 18, 2011, Judge Muir attended the reorganization and nomination meeting of the Charles F. Greevy, Jr. American Inn of Court, of which he had been a Charter member and intense supporter. An ongoing documentary of his life and works, remembrances and impact on the law is still in the works. An outstanding memorial service was held at the Community Arts Center on August 12, 2011, followed by a very moving and church-filled celebration of his life on August 13th, at Trinity Episcopal Church.

Discussions continued for the Law Association's interest to provide input and substance to the Community Mural project developed by Michael Pilato. Raising funds, sharing ideas and nominations and a process for identifying locations, time-line, and implementation is essential.

As documented in the Pennsylvania Bar Association Charter, Article III, Purpose, "to perpetuate the history of the profession and the memory of its members". The LLA Bar History Committee strives to achieve and foster this purpose with everyone's input, interest and involvement, which is encouraged, as we engage in the practice of law in Lycoming County.
