LAW DAY 2012 ANNUAL REPORT

The Law Day program was once again a successful event with many essay submissions from students in the Kindergarten through 7th grade. The Committee returned to sending the invitations by regular mail in 2012 as opposed to e-mail, which was successful in increasing participation by students in the lower grades. However, the Committee received no participation from high school students for the second year in a row and few submissions of artwork from the lower grades.

The Law Day ceremony was held on May 4, 2012, which Judge McCoy officiated on behalf of the Court with the other Judges participating. The Law Day singers sang the National Anthem and Senior Judge Brown was the guest of honor. For the first time during the Law Day Ceremonies, John Pietrovito presented awards to the Regional Champions of the Mock Trial Competition.

However, the Lycoming County Paralegal Association hosted a pizza and cake party for the winners and their families immediately after the ceremony as it has done in the past.
