Each of these attorneys made lasting contributions and service to the practice of law, their colleagues, and their memories will be long held by the Bar and Community.

A very significant task was undertaken, and completed, as the Committee met on four occasions and developed a “Guideline for Resolutions and Services” for deceased local attorneys. These were approved by the LLA Executive Committee on June 7, 2015, and are on the LLA website. Specific and significant topics are still pending, including:

1. A hard bound update of “Historical Sketches” should be discussed and decided.
2. City mural for attorneys; recent contact with artist Michael Pilato.
3. Articles of specific interest and local historic perspective.

Attorney members and other interested and concerned persons are encouraged to join and/or advise the Bar History Committee. Convenient and appropriate meetings are be scheduled for input, interest and involvement in this important aspect of our practice and legal experiences.
