Thomas C. Raup, retired Judge, died August 30, 2016, Service held on September 30, 2016.

Clinton W. Smith, Senior Judge, died December 30, 2016, Service to be scheduled.

Each of these attorneys and Judges made lasting contributions and service to the practice of law, their colleagues, Lycoming County and their memories and stories will be long held by the Bar and Community.

A very significant project was undertaken, as the Committee has already met on four occasions, to develop, plan, and to help coordinate the activities and celebration for the 150th Anniversary of the LLA in 2019. Several initial tasks and endeavors identified, include: updating the initial Marshall Anspach book, HISTORICAL SKETCHES, and 1989 supplement edition; oral and video interviews with LLA members and others of timely changes and perspectives of the practice of law; identifying and perpetuating documents, photographs, special occasions, and memorabilia of the local law community, Judges, and lawyers, as well as:


1. A hard bound update of “Historical Sketches” should be discussed and decided.
