RE: Annual Report of the Education Committee for 2017

The Education Committee continued its efforts to provide the members of the Lycoming Law Association with the opportunity to obtain most, if not all, of their required CLE credits and avoid traveling outside of Lycoming County.

First, the LLA periodically receives a list of videotaped seminars sponsored by the Pennsylvania Bar Institute. The lists were reviewed and topics thought to be of interest to members of the LLA were selected for presentation at the LLA office.

Second, the Eat and Earn (formerly "Lunch and Learn") seminars continued throughout 2017 through the efforts of our Executive Director, Michele Frey, and the willingness of members of the LLA to present topics of interest to the membership. Members of the LLA are invited and encouraged to contact Michele Frey or John Pietrovito if they wish to present a topic for an Eat and Earn Seminar or if they have a suggestion for a topic and/or person(s) to present a topic. In 2017, the Eat & Earn Seminars were expanded to two (2) seminars per month on a "trial basis." In addition, there were video replays of previous Eat & Earn Seminars in each of the three (3) compliance months, i.e., April, August and December. The Education Committee is recommending that both of these changes be continued in 2018.

Finally, the Lycoming Law Association continued its practice of providing webcasts of seminars in 2107 at the LLA office.
