Re: Young Lawyers Division Annual Report for 2025

February 27, 2025: YLD meeting

The meeting was hosted in downtown Williamsport with approximately 12 attendees. All attendees actively discussed plans for events for the upcoming year and how we could provide a welcoming environment for new attorneys. Blake Marks attended PBA's YLD Summit for Lycoming County in summer 2024, and we informed all other YLD members who attended this meeting of the opportunity to potentially join Blake Marks in attending the summit in 2025.

April 12, 2025: Wills for Heroes

The YLD partnered with the PBA and LLA to help sponsor the *Wills for Heroes* program. It is a free program that provides Wills, Living Wills, Health Care and Financial Powers of Attorney to first responders and military veterans and their spouses/partners. Multiple YLD members teamed up with experienced estate planning attorneys to provide these free legal services to those who deserve it most.

May 1 – June 30, 2025: Project Linus Blanket Drive

The YLD held its annual blanket donation drive to benefit Project Linus. A non-profit which collects new homemade blankets, blanket making supplies, materials and no-sew blanket kits to distributed to children in hospitals, shelters, social service agencies, or anywhere that a child "might be in need of a big hug." Over 50 handmade blankets were donated at the Lycoming Law Association and the Lycoming County Courthouse. With the assistance of the LLA Director, the LLA YLD's blanket drive received televised attention through a WNEP interview shown on the 5 PM news.

July 30 – August 1, 2025: PBA YLD Summer Summit

Both Blake Marks and Giovanna Daniele represented our local LLA when attending the PBA YLD Summer Summit at Camelback Resort.

September 14, 2025: PBA YLD Zone 4 Event at Knoebels

The LLA YLD organized a day of fun at Knoebel's Amusement Resort. Many Zone 4 members and their families attended. Those in attendance enjoyed lunch at the pavilion and a day at the amusement park.

November 10 – December 11, 2025: Angel Tree Toy Drive

The YLD held its annual Toy Drive to benefit the Salvation Army and Susquehanna Valley CASA. These two organizations served over 500 local families for the 2025 holidays through our donations. Four large roller totes of toys, games, books, and clothes were collected.

December 4, 2025: Eight new lawyers were inducted into Lycoming County courts and the YLD, all eight new inductees were automatically eligible for YLD membership.
