*The Law Day 2020 theme is: “Your Vote, Your Voice, Our Democracy: The 19th Amendment at 100.”*

**Essay Contest for Grade 6-12**

Write an essay, not to exceed 1,000 words on the subject:  
*Do you believe that the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment brought substantial change for women in America?*  
or  
*What do you think the suffragettes would think about American society today? Was the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment caused women to achieve equality?*

**Art Contest (All Grades)**

Art projects include posters, dioramas, videos, poems, creative writings, photography, songs etc.

Art submissions should not be any larger than 4 feet by 4 feet.

Video or song submissions may not exceed five minutes.

*Art Contest Theme: Your Vote, Your Voice, Our Democracy: The 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment at 100*

The following information must be placed on the back of all entries: Student’s Name, Grade, Teacher, School and School Telephone Number. All entries are property of the Lycoming Law Association and are subject to public presentation, display and/or viewing. Submissions to the Law Day Contest will not be returned.
