the opposing party and directly to Courtroom No. 5 ten (10) days prior to trial.	
1. The Witness List sha	all be a list of witnesses to be called at

the hearing as part of a party's case (excluding the child), a brief offer of proof as

to each witness, and the estimated time for direct examination.

- The Court may exercise its right to preclude cumulative, repetitive, or irrelevant testimony.
- 3. A failure to timely file the required Witness List may result in the preclusion or limitation of testimony or other appropriate sanctions in the discretion of the Court.
- II. <u>EXHIBIT LISTS:</u> Exhibits Lists shall be filed with copies given to the opposing party and **directly to Courtroom No. 5** ten (10) days prior to trial.
- Exhibit Lists shall provide brief but sufficiently detailed explanations of each Exhibit.
- 2. Exhibits shall be pre-marked using a familial distinction, the party's relationship to the child (i.e. "Father's # 1"), if at all applicable, rather than plaintiff or defendant, etc.
- 3. Parties shall mark as exhibits current report cards for school age children.
- 4. A copy of all actual Exhibits shall be given to the opposing party ten (10) days prior to trial.
- Original Exhibits shall be provided to the Court, pre-marked,
 at the commencement of the trial.
- 6. Exhibits should not be filed and should not be provided to the Court prior to the commencement of trial.

- III. PROPOSED CUSTODY ORDER: A detailed proposed custody order shall be delivered directly to Courtroom No. 5 ten (10) days prior to trial with copies given to the opposing party. The proposed custody order shall detail a proposed physical custody schedule including a holiday and vacation schedule, and exchange locations. THE PROPOSED CUSTODY ORDERS SHALL NOT BE FILED WITH THE PROTHONOTARY.
- IV. <u>CRIMINAL/ABUSE HISTORY VERIFICATION:</u> Five (5) days prior to trial, all parties must file and serve upon all other parties an updated Criminal/Abuse History Verification pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1915.3-2.
