OPINION IN SUPPORT OF ORDER DATED MARCH 28, 2001 IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(A) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

Appellant/Plaintiff appeals from this Court's Order of March 28, 2001, in which her Motion for Post-Trial Relief, interpreted as a request for reconsideration, was denied.
