OPINION IN SUPPORT OF THE ORDER OF September 4, 2002, IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

Ronald W. Bunting filed a Notice of Appeal on September 13, 2002. On September 16, 2002, this Court issued an order pursuant to Pa. R.A.P. 1925(b) directing Bunting to file a concise statement of the matters complained of on appeal. Bunting's matters complained of were due on September 30, 2002. As of October 22, 2002, Bunting has failed to file his matters complained of on appeal.

The Court is unaware of any basis for the appeal. Therefore the Court cannot issue an opinion in support of its Order and Sentence pursuant to Pa. R.A.P. 1925(a) without receiving the Matters Complained of on Appeal. The Court recommends that the Superior Court dismiss the appeal, because of Bunting's failure to comply with the Rules of Appellate Procedure.
