OPINION IN SUPPORT OF THE ORDER OF APRIL 23, 2002, IN COMPLIANCE
WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, Bureau of Motor

Vehicles has filed an appeal of this Court's Order of April 23, 2002. The Appellant has also filed a
