## <u>ORDER</u>

AND NOW, this \_\_\_\_ day of June 2004, upon consideration of the Defendant's Omnibus Pre-trial Motion, it is ORDERED and DIRECTED as follows:

- 1. Habeas Corpus After review of the preliminary hearing transcripts and the testimony presented at the hearing before the Court on or about March 31, 2004, the request for a writ of habeas corpus is denied. The Court feels the Commonwealth presented sufficient evidence to support the charges against Defendant.
- 2. Motion to Compel Answer to Bill of Particulars At the hearing the Commonwealth agreed it would promptly file an answer to the request for a bill of particulars. If the Commonwealth has not already done so, it shall file a written answer to the request for a bill of particulars within ten days of receipt of this Order.
- 3. Motion to Suppress The Court denies Defendant's motion to suppress evidence. The Court finds the police had probable cause that the Defendant was engaged in the delivery of a controlled substance as an accomplice and/or co-conspirator.
- 4. The Court believes the motions relating to bail and other crimes evidence are most and/or addressed by previous Orders.
