**O R D E R**

AND NOW, this \_\_\_\_ day of January 2004, upon consideration of Count VIII of Defendant's Sixth Supplemental Omnibus Pretrial Motion, a motion to exclude phone conversations of the Defendant recorded by the County Prison,<sup>1</sup> it is ORDERED and DIRECTED as follows:

The Court DENIES the request to exclude, but ORDERS the Commonwealth to provide the defense with copies of the phone conversations as follows: The defense shall provide blank compact discs (CDs) to the Commonwealth by 5:00 p.m. on January 8, 2004. The Commonwealth shall provide a copy of those phone conversations that occurred on or before December 31, 2003 to the defense by January 15, 2004. Any phone conversations from January 2004 shall provided as soon thereafter as possible, but not later than one business day prior to being utilized at trial.
