**OPINION IN SUPPORT OF THE ORDER OF JANUARY 12, 2005 IN COMPLIANCE
WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE**

Appellant Jersey Shore Area School District has appealed this court's January 12, 2005 order. In the order, the court granted Appellee Ophelia Fetter's appeal from a determination of the Jersey Shore Area School District School Board. The court determined that the School Board had erred in finding that Fetter had abandoned her position as an elementary school principal with the School District. Upon this determination, the court ordered that Fetter was to be reinstated to her former position.

On February 10, 2005, the School District filed a Notice of Appeal. On February 14, 2005, the court issued an order in compliance with Pa.R.A.P. 1925(b) directing the School District to file a Concise Statement of Matters Complained of on Appeal within fourteen days of the order. The School District filed its Statement of Matter on March 4, 2005.

The court believes that the issues raised in the Statement of Matters have been addressed by the court's written opinion in support of the January 12, 2005 order. That opinion

was also issued on January 15, 2005. Accordingly, the January 15, 2005 order should be affirmed and the appeal denied.
