## **OPINION AND VERDICT**

Before the Court for determination of guilt or innocence are nine counts of violating 35 P.S. § 780-113 (31) possession of a small amount of marijuana with intent to distribute it but not to sell it, or the distribution of a small amount of marijuana but not for sale.

All of the counts relate to Defendant's alleged conduct involving a then minor Tiffany Hollenthoner.

The Court reviewed the testimony of Ms. Hollenthoner and finds no evidence to support the allegation that the Defendant either possessed a small amount of marijuana with the intent to distribute it or actually distributed a small amount of marijuana but not for sale. Accordingly, the Court finds the Defendant <u>Not Guilty</u> on Counts 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9.
