OPINION
Issued pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 1925(a)

On November 1, 2010 the Defendant filed a Petition for Relief under the Post Conviction Relief Act (PCRA). After an independent review of the entire record, the Court agreed with PCRA counsel and found that the Defendant failed to raise any meritorious issues in his PCRA Petition. Accordingly, by Order dated March 9, 2011 this Court notified the Defendant that his PCRA petition would be dismissed, and granted PCRA counsel's application for leave to withdraw appearance. On April 6, 2011, this Court entered its final Order dismissing the Defendant's PCRA Petition.

On May 3, 2011 the Defendant filed a Notice of Appeal. On May 4, 2011 this Court issued an Order Pursuant to Pa.R.A.P. 1925(b) requiring the Defendant to file a Concise Statement of the Errors Complained of on Appeal within twenty-one days.

Defendant's Concise Statement merely provides that the error complained of on appeal is that the PCRA Action was dismissed. For purposes of this appeal, this

Court relies upon its Opinion dated March 9, 2011 and this Court respectfully requests affirmance of its April 6, 2011 Order.
