OPINION IN SUPPORT OF ORDER IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

The Defendant appeals the Order of the Court dated October 20, 2010, which denied the Defendant's Motion to Suppress, and the Court's Order of March 3, 2011, which found the Defendant guilty of two counts of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.
