## OPINION IN SUPPORT OF ORDER IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

This Opinion is written in support of the Court's Order of August 16, 2017, denying Defendant's second Petition for Post Conviction Relief.
