OPINION IN SUPPORT OF ORDER IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE

This opinion is written in support of this court's Order entered March 7, 2018, which granted Appellee Ashley Schaeffer's motion to preclude the Appellant from admitting the results of Appellee's blood test with respect to the alleged presence of Buprenorphine, a non-prescribed Schedule III controlled substance, and Norbuprenorphine, a metabolite of Buprenorphine. As explained in the Opinion accompanying that order, the Department has not prescribed minimum levels for these controlled substances; therefore, the court precluded the introduction of this evidence based on the clear and unambiguous language of 75 Pa. C.S. §1747(c)(4).
