**OPINION IN SUPPORT OF THE COURT'S
ORDER OF DECEMBER 16, 2021
IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 1925(a) OF THE
RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE**

Jeffrey W. Wolfe (hereinafter referred to as "Appellant") files this appeal following this Court's Custody Order dated December 10, 2021 and docketed December 16, 2021. Appellant's Notice of Appeal was timely filed on January 7, 2022.¹ Appellant timely filed his Concise Statement of Errors Complained of on Appeal on February 11, 2022 citing the following matters complained of:

1. Whether the Court improperly applied the custody factors in reaching its decision;
2. Whether the Court improperly weighed the custody factors in reaching its decision; and
3. Whether the Court's decision was against the weight of the evidence presented at trial.

The Court's December 16, 2021 Order as well as the transcript of December 7, 2021, which are considered the Opinion of the Court in support of said Order, should be affirmed and Appellant's appeal denied. The Order and transcript provide a
