ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Recognizing that casual dress codes invite casual behavior, the Court of Common Pleas of Lycoming County hereby adopts the following Dress Code Policy.

All persons attending proceedings in the courtrooms of the Court of Common Pleas, are reminded that they are appearing in a Court of Law. Therefore, all persons shall be dressed appropriately, cleanly and neatly, consistent with the dignity, decorum, and seriousness of the proceedings.

The following dress shall be required:

- No dirty, ripped or torn clothing
- No shorts
- No sleepwear
- No outdoor jackets
- With religious and medical exception, no hats, headscarves, headbands or kerchiefs may be worn
- No flip-flops or house shoes shall be permitted
- Clothing that advertises substances (drugs, alcohol, tobacco products) or language or writing that is otherwise inappropriate or offensive (sex, profanity, racial or ethnic slurs, or gang related attire) may not be worn.
- Tattoos that display drugs, sex, alcohol or tobacco products, or gang related signs or symbols must not be seen at any time.
- Trousers are to be worn at the waistline and shirttails are to be tucked in.
- Shoulders, backs, chests and midriffs are to be covered.


