**AMENDED ORDER**

The Lycoming County Law Association has requested that the Court amend its Orders of Court of February 5, 1991, and January 23, 1992, whereby members of the Association were permitted to designate the Lycoming County Bar Association Foundation as the recipient of certain funds which would otherwise be received by said member for service as members of a Board of Arbitration hearing matters within Lycoming County.

The members of the Lycoming Law Association have requested that the Court amend its previous Order to permit members to designate one, two, or all arbitration fees received in a calendar year, effective January 1, 2006, and otherwise request that the Court ratify a plan whereby members may voluntarily make such a contribution to the Lycoming County Law Association Foundation with the understanding that the Foundation in its discretion will utilize such funds to support North Penn Legal Services and/or other qualifying non-profit organizations providing legal services to the indigent, as part of the members' pro bono support of the efforts of the Foundation and non-profit organizations providing legal services to the indigent.

The Court continues to support the efforts of members of the Lycoming Law Association in engaging in such pro bono activity and enters the following Order:

**ORDER OF COURT**


AND NOW, this 14 day of Dec., 2005, it is hereby ORDERED  
and DECREED that the Orders of Court of February 5, 1991, and January 23, 1992, are  
hereby amended and,

It is ORDERED and DIRECTED that the Prothonotary of Lycoming County be  
directed, upon receipt of a properly executed authorization form, attached as Exhibit "A",  
directing the Controller of Lycoming County to forward to the Lycoming County Law  
Association Foundation one, two or all arbitration fees normally received by the attorney  
submitting the authorization form for service as a member of a Board of Arbitration.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DIRECTED that the appropriate fiscal office of  
Lycoming County shall comply with the directions of the Prothonotary concerning the  
forwarding of such funds to the Lycoming County Law Association Foundation, and the  
Lycoming County Law Association Foundation is hereby authorized to utilize the funds  
received pursuant to directions set forth in the authorization form. The Prothonotary and the  
appropriate fiscal office shall implement and coordinate such procedures as are necessary to  
carry out the directions of this Order.

The Prothonotary of Lycoming County is hereby directed to forward a copy of this Order to the appropriate fiscal office of Lycoming County, the Lycoming County Law Association Foundation and all members of the Lycoming Law Association.
