► Commonwealth vs. Bowen (06/17/2025)—Judge Ryan M. Tira

Criminal: Habeas corpus petition; sufficiency of evidence of possession with intent to deliver drugs where defendant was present for buy by confidential informant; prima facie case of criminal use of communication facility where underlying delivery charges were dismissed; duty of disclosure of criminal charges, promises of leniency or for immunity offered to informant. ► Nash vs. Nash (05/06/2025)—Judge Ryan C. Gardner

Divorce: Enforcement of marital settlement agreement; interpretation of clear and unambiguous contract. (Nash050625RG) (Posted: June 17, 2025)

►GR Adoption (04/11/2025)—Judge Ryan C. Gardner

Adoption: Petition for involuntary termination of parental rights; parent demonstrates settled purpose to relinquish parental claim to child or fails to perform parental duties for at least six months; no contact with child and contact prohibited due to criminal conviction; existence of bond. (GR041125RG) (Posted: June 17, 2025)

▶Barnes v. Barnes (06/27/2025)—Judge Ryan C. Gardner

Custody: Appeal of custody trial; application of Kayden's Law factors; duty to weigh all the evidence and not give greater weight to witnesses due to their status as a licensed psychologist, a medical provider, a first assistant district attorney and the Office of Children and Youth; consideration of guardian ad litem's testimony in custody trial where guardian did not file a final report prior to trial; ex parte communication with guardian; obligation of court to consider mental health of mother; appropriateness of guardian's representation of children; issues on appeal not raised during the trial; claim of court bias related to questioning of child; weight given to various witnesses and testimony; viability of the court's change of opinion based on totality of evidence. Criminal: Juvenile matter; motion to admit out of court statements of minor victim; analysis of statements to determine if they possess particularized guarantees of trustworthiness; spontaneity and consistency of statements; motive of adults who heard the statements to fabricate statements.
