Civil: Preliminary objections; rescission of automobile insurance contract after motor vehicle accident; indispensable party; alleged misrepresentations relating to the issuance of the policy; joinder of all parties to an insurance contract as necessary parties; defamation claim related to reports made to Pennsylvania Attorney General's office; sufficiency of pleading to state allegation of lack of probable cause that overcomes statutory immunity.
