Civil: Motion for post-trial relief; allegations of errors in findings of fact and conclusions of law; clarification of factual findings; authority of trial court in non-jury trial; burden of proof; credibility determinations; failure to prove causation and damages; application of negligence per se doctrine where regulations did not clearly apply to township at time of claimed violation; weight of evidence; recovery for negligence, gross negligence and willful misconduct where causation hasn't been proven; proof of causation to recover for public nuisance; proof that township exceeded stormwater easement; entitlement to injunction where causation not demonstrated; discretion of court in conduct of trial. 
