Old Business

The staffing shortage in both the Public Defender's Office and the District Attorney's Office continues.

New Business

Judge Butts reported on the implementation of Act 44 pertaining to early release from supervision. The Act becomes effective June 11, 2025. It will require the District Attorney's Office to interview victims in all cases where the person under supervision becomes eligible. At the present time there are approximately 60 eligible individuals.

Judge Butts also discussed the four divisions of treatment court. They are Veteran's Court, mental health court, drug court and DUI court. Lycoming County has certificates from the AOPC in all four divisions. Supreme Court Justice Brobson will attend and participate in the next graduation of participants in drug and alcohol divisions. Chief Justice Todd will attend and participate in the next graduation of the participants in the Veterans and mental health courts. Judge Butts has been appointed by the Supreme Court to a statewide leadership position in treatment courts.

There were no agenda items presented by the Chairmen of the LLA committees.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:20 p.m.
