Criminal: Post Conviction Relief Act petition; unavailability of witness due to memory loss; applicability of forfeiture by wrongdoing doctrine to both direct and cross-examination; waiver by failure to attempt to call witness at trial; discretion of court in admitting relevant testimony; hearsay; out-of-court statement offered to explain a course of conduct; prejudice; claim of judge shopping due to district attorney’s request that a senior judge be removed from presiding in criminal cases; issues previously litigated; standard for recusal; failure to seek mistrial for prejudicial statement from tape; prejudice for failure to call witness; after-discovered evidence that could have been obtained before trial; proprietorial argument encouraging a jury to send a message to the defendant. 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
