Criminal: Appeal; ineffective counsel for failure to depose witnesses and to interview prior counsel; assessment of review performed by post-conviction counsel. (Holmes050222t) (Posted: May 23, 2022)
- ▶ **HB Adoption** (05/11/2022)—Judge Ryan M. Tira
Adoption: Agency petition for involuntary termination of parental rights; settled purpose of relinquishing parental claim; failure to perform parental duties for at least the six months preceding the filing of the petition; parent noncompliant with the permanency plan; parent not addressing incapacities that caused child to be removed from care; continued bond with mother; bonding assessment to determine whether bond is worth saving or whether termination would cause irreparable harm. - ▶ **Commonwealth vs. Fogan** (05/02/2022)—Judge Kenneth D. Brown
Criminal: Appeal of homicide conviction; admissibility of multiple camera angles of robbery and homicide; discretion of trial court; depictions of different information to meet various elements of Commonwealth's burden of proof; voir dire; refusal to strike a prospective juror for cause; burden of proving that a prospective juror should be excused for cause; statement of defendant showing consciousness of guilt; refusal to charge for third-degree murder where acts clearly constituted second-degree murder, jury confusion; mandatory imposition of court costs.
