RESOLUTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE COURT:

The Honorable Judge Nancy L. Butts, President Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Lycoming County, 29th Judicial District, by Order dated October 16, 2024, appointed the undersigned Committee to draft appropriate Resolutions memorializing the life of Henry G. Hager, III, Esquire, and to present those Resolutions at a Special Session of Court to be held on November 14, 2024. The Committee reports as follows:

1. Henry George Hager, III was born on April 28, 1934, in Williamsport, Pennsylvania. He died on June 27, 2024, at the age of 90.
2. He was the elder of two children born to Eleanor Watt Hager and Henry G. Hager, MD. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Gretchen Telek.
3. He graduated from Wesleyan University in 1956. He enrolled in the University of Pennsylvania Law School received his law degree in 1959 and was admitted to the Pennsylvania Bar in January, 1960.
4. In 1958, Henry married Sallie Ann Parish and together they were the devoted parents to two children: Hannah and Eleanor.
5. Henry became the Special Deputy Attorney General on 1962 and served in that position until 1963.
6. Henry was elected as the Lycoming County District Attorney in 1964 and served until his term ended in 1968.
7. In 1964 Henry joined the firm Wood, Stuart & Murphy. In 1966 the firm became known as Stuart, Murphy, Hager & Smith.

8. Henry G. Hager, III was elected to the Pennsylvania Senate in 1972, serving until 1984. In 1980 he was elected President Pro Tempore. During his time in the Senate, Henry was vital in the passing of Pennsylvania's Contributory Negligence Act and creating the Catastrophic Loss Fund.
9. In 1984 Henry left the Pennsylvania Senate to work for the Insurance Federation of Pennsylvania. In 1998 he retired.
10. Henry was a great mentor to many and affectionately known as "Mere" by most (due to his initials).

AND NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that as a result of the passing of Henry G. Hager, III, the Bar of Lycoming County has lost a respected and conscientious member who upheld and exemplified the highest traditions of the legal profession; Williamsport has lost a valued participant in the community; his family has lost a devoted, kind and loving father and grandfather; and his friends and acquaintances have lost a fine gentleman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we, the undersigned, joined in by all members of the Lycoming County Bar, do hereby recognize and mourn the passing of Henry G. Hager, III.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Court and this Bar do hereby extend to Henry

G. Hager, III's children and grandchildren our deep and heartfelt expression of sympathy.

AND BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY that this Resolution be spread at length upon the records of the Court of Common Pleas of Lycoming County, and that copies be sent to his children, and published in the Lycoming Reporter.
