Essay Contest: What is it about the Constitution that makes it important to us today? What amendments or changes do you think should be made to it?
 Grades K-5 – Not to exceed 300 words.
 Grades 6-12 – Not to exceed 1,000 words.

Art Contest: Art projects can be about the Constitution or any of its amendments. Art projects include posters, dioramas, videos, poems, creative writings, photography, songs etc. Art submissions should not be any larger than 4 feet by 4 feet. Video or song submissions may not exceed five minutes.
