► **Commonwealth v. Mayo** (09/11/2026)—Judge Ryan M. Tira

Criminal: Motion to dismiss due to prejudicial delay involving claimed sexual abuse of child; actual prejudice necessary to establish due process violation; delay in investigation without intention of gaining a tactical advantage; speculative or conclusory claim of prejudice from passage of time, including undefined memory issues, missing witness claims, and claimed inability to raise age-related competency issues; suppression motion related to questioning without Miranda rights having been given; totality of the circumstances under which police interview is considered custodial; voluntariness of waiver of Miranda rights; discretion of court to conduct competency hearing of 14 year old child; factors in considering motion for modification of bail. ► **Commonwealth v. Schmeckenbecher** (09/04/2026)—Judge Ryan C. Gardner

Civil: Appeal of summary trial verdict; definition of ATV for purposes of determining if a particular vehicle may be operated on a roadway; duty of Pennsylvania to subordinate its public policy within its borders to laws of vehicle licensing state.
