- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Spencer (07/25/2025)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Suppression motion; reasonable suspicion for vehicle search where there is reasonable belief that drug transaction had occurred in vehicle; probable cause for arrest; attempt to flee police and punching an officer as consciousness of guilt; witness statements supporting drug transaction; habeas corpus petition; sufficiency of evidence of aggravated assault where defendant struck police officer causing injuries to area of eye; sufficiency of evidence of escape and resisting arrest where defendant was under arrest and in the hospital for body cavity search, when he fled the examination area and struggled with officers; prima facia case of delivery of drugs, even though there is no eyewitness testimony; sufficiency of evidence of tampering where defendant pushed cocaine into his rectum. (Spencer072525bt) (Posted: July 29, 2025)
- ▶ Commonwealth vs. Fogan (07/18/2025)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Post conviction relief act petition; ineffective counsel in murder conviction; failure of counsel to object to prosecutor's statement that this is not a death penalty case; lack of prejudice; charge to jury that they should ignore consequences of verdict; overwhelming evidence of guilt; failure to object to agent's helpful narration of surveillance video; propriety of agent's testimony on personal perceptions of evidence; prejudice related to testimony that defendant was identified by probation officer. (Fogan071825bt) (Posted: July 27, 2025)
- ► Commonwealth vs. Spencer (07/22/2025)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Habeas corpus petition; sufficiency of evidence of drug delivery where police officer observed hand-to-hand transaction and admission of drug purchaser. (Spencer072225bt) (Posted: July 27, 2025)
- ► Commonwealth vs. Vaughn (07/21/2025)—Judge Nancy L. Butts Criminal: Habeas corpus petition; prima facia evidence of materially false written statement for firearm purchase; defenses of confusion or lack of intent for jury. (Vaughn072125bt) (Posted: July 27, 2025)
